

BALL AND CAP GAME

Phonics- Beginner (KS-1/2)

Learning outcomes: To be able to associate letters with sounds.

Instructions:



- Invite pupils to make a circle. Give one pupil a hat and another pupil a ball.
- Fill the hat with the letter sound cards (page 2).
- Start to play music while the pupils pass around the hat and the ball.
- When the music stops, encourage the pupil with the hat to take out one letter sound card and read the sound out loud, not the letter.
- *E.g.* “sss” = ‘s’
- Instruct the pupil with the ball to guess the letter(s).

Materials required:

- “Letter sound cards” sheet (page 2).
- A ball.
- A hat.

Tip!

Instead of playing music, you can turn your back and call out ‘stop’.

You can also ask the pupil with the ball to think of a word including the sound if he/she is confident enough.
