



# INTRODUCING YOUR PARTNER

Food & Drink - Beginner (KS-1/2)

**Learning outcomes:** To be able to describe someone else's preferences

## Instructions



- Pair pupils up: one native English speaker with an EAL pupil. The EAL pupil will be responsible for introducing his/her classmate.
- Encourage EAL pupil to ask his/her classmate questions such as what their name is, what they like to eat/drink and what their favourite food/drink is.
- Ask EAL pupil to recite their classmate's answers to the rest of the class/group.
- If EAL pupil gives any incorrect information, their classmate will indicate this with a "thumbs-down", but if it is correct, their classmate indicates "thumbs up".
- Ask the native English speaker to give the right answer and encourage EAL pupil to repeat.

### Tip!

Pupils can introduce their partner when the teacher comes to their table, or in front of the class.

For more advanced levels, EAL pupil can write the native pupil's answers.
