Instructions:







- Give each pupil an "adverbs" sheet (page 2).
- Nominate pupils to read adverbs aloud.
- Ask pupils to cut out each sentence, in blue, at a time (page 2).
- Ask pupils to arrange pieces into a full sentence.
- Check sentences with the whole class.
- · Ask pupils to cut out adverbs (page 2).
- Ask pupils to choose different adverbs to place in their sentences.
- Nominate pupils to read their sentences aloud.
- Ask pupils to stick sentences in their books.
