Maths - Beginner (KS-1/2)

Learning outcomes: To be able to follow and carry out different directions.

Game I Instructions - Following simple directions







- Select a destination in the classroom, e.g. a chair.
- Place the "vocabulary cards" so all pupils can see them (page 2).
- Nominate a pupil who is going to be following the directions.
- Start by giving the selected pupil the first direction to get to the destination point, e.g. walk 8 steps forward.
- Ask another pupil to provide the next direction for the selected pupil to follow (using the vocabulary cards for support).
- Continue to ask different pupils to provide directions until the selected pupil reaches their destination point.
- Repeat the activity with different pupils.

Materials required:

"Vocabulary cards" sheet (page 2).

Game 2 Instructions - Writing simple directions









- Place the "destination pictures" (page 3) around the classroom etc.
- Ask pupils work in small groups.
- Give each group a "destination picture".
- On whiteboards, ask pupils to write a set of directions on how to get to their destination.
- Encourage pupils to checking and reviewing their directions to ensure they are accurate.
- Once completed, ask the pupils to swap their directions with another group to see if they can follow them.
- Encourage the pupils to peer-assess their writing.




