

BUILD A WALL

Connecting Sentences - Beginner (KS-1/2)

Learning outcomes: To be able to correctly use different connectives in a sentence.

Instructions - Build a wall



- Give each group/pair a “Build a wall” sheet (page 2).
- Tell pupils to pretend they are builders.
- Explain to pupils that their job will be to build sentence walls.
- Ask pupils to select a ‘brick’ from each category.
- Ask pupils to make a full sentence based on the bricks selected.
- Explain to pupils that each number represents how many connectives they must use in their sentences e.g. ‘4’ requires choosing four connectives.

Materials required:

- “Build a wall” sheet (page 2).

Remember to use the correct number of connectives.
