



DESCRIPTIVE WRITING KITS: THE WHITE HORSE

English Language - Beginner (KS1/2)

Learning outcomes: To be able to describe a scene using the different senses.

Instructions - The White Horse



- Print “Snapshot Screen” sheet (page 2) in colour.
- Print “Senses Word Mat” sheet (page 3) for each pupil.
- Stick or project “Snapshot Screen” sheet on the whiteboard.
- Ask pupils to imagine that they are in the scene.
- Give each pupil a copy of “Senses Word Mat” sheet (page 3).
- Ask pupils to complete their worksheet.
