



PHOTO CARD PRACTICE: ME, MY FAMILY AND FRIENDS MARRIAGE/PARTNERSHIP

French - GCSE

Learning outcomes: To prepare for the photo card speaking section of the GCSE exam.

Instructions



- Print a “Photo Card Practice” sheet (page 3) for each student.
- Show pupils the photo (page 2) on the board or printed in groups.
- Ask pupils to guess the topic of the picture and discuss possible questions the examiner might ask with a partner.
- Give pupils a copy of “Photo Card Practice”.
- Ask pupils to read the key vocabulary and possible questions and see if they had the same predictions.
- Ask pupils to make notes in the box on what is happening in the picture and ideas for answers to the questions.
- Get pupils to practise asking and answering questions with their partner.

- “Photo” sheet (page 2)
- “Photo Card Practice” sheet (page 3)
