Intermediate (KS3/4)

Learning outcomes: Pupils are able to accurately identify a range of measurements.

Instructions

- Print “Measurements” (page 2) sheet.
- Exercise A: Ask pupils to write the types of measurements into the different categories.
- Ask students to compare answers with a partner then check answers with the whole class.
- Exercise B: Ask pupils to look at each picture and write the measurements in full underneath. e.g. ‘Two hundred grams’.
- Check answers as a class.

Materials required:

- “Measurements?” sheet (page 2)

Tip!

Ask pupils what typical things we use each measurement for, e.g. pints for milk.
