



GROW A PLANT

Science
Beginner (KS1/2)

Learning outcomes: To be able to use investigation words for scientific experiments.

Instructions



- Print “Grow a plant” sheet (page 2) for each pupil.
- Explain to pupils that they will grow a plant (decide which plant).
- Put pupils into pairs and ask them to research the plant.
- Explain to pupils how to complete the worksheet.
- Write the investigation words on the whiteboard and check pronunciation.
- Ask pupils to compare their worksheets with a neighbour.
- Draw pupils’ attention to the investigation words and relate them to the worksheet.
- Ask pupils to use the investigation words to describe and justify their answers. For example, “**My plan**” is the method because it explains each step.

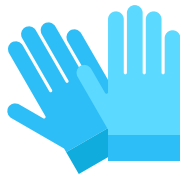
