Learning outcomes: To be able to ask and answer simple questions about climates.

Instructions - Climate Features



- Print “Climate Features” sheet (page 2) for each pupil.
- Give each pupil a copy of the sheet.
- Ask pupils to talk about each picture and what climate it would be describing.
- Ask pupils to sort the pictures into each climate.

Materials required:

- “Climate Features” sheet (page 2)

Instructions - Climate Change



- Print “Climate Change” sheet (page 3) for each pair.
- Put pupils into pairs.
- Give each pair a copy of the sheet.
- Ask pupils to describe each picture in pairs and what they think it is showing.
- Ask pupils to cut out and sort the pictures in the table.
- Have a discussion with the class about the effects of climate change, using the images as a basis for conversation.

Materials required:

- “Climate Change” sheet (page 3)

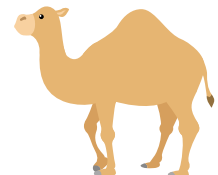
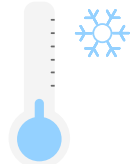
