



WHERE, WEAR, WERE, WE'RE

Fluency Boost - Geography
Beginner (KS1/2)

Learning outcomes: To be able to differentiate 'where', 'wear', 'were' and 'we're'.

Instructions:



- Print the "Where, wear, were, we're" worksheet (pages 2 and 3).
- Review the differences between 'where', 'wear', 'were' and 'we're' with the class.
- Ask the pupils to look at the pictures and example sentences in pairs and write a sentence for each word according to the picture.
- Take feedback from the class on example sentences.
- Ask pupils to complete the next exercise, by completing the sentences with the correct answer. Review answers as a class.
- Ask pupils to write their own sentences about the classroom, their teachers or classmates.

Differentiation:

- ★ Encourage pupils to use a combination of 'where', 'wear', 'were' and 'we're' in their sentences. Perhaps provide a prize if all 4 can be used in a sentence!

Materials required:

- One "Where, wear, were, we're" worksheet (pages 2 and 3) per pupil



<p>where</p> <p>'Where' is an adverb used to talk about location, such as asking questions or providing more information about a place.</p>		<p>Where are you?</p> <p>I went to the park where we had a picnic.</p> <hr/> <hr/>
<p>wear</p> <p>'Wear' is a verb used to describe the clothes you have on.</p>		<p>I like to wear my green jumper.</p> <p>In the summer, my family wear matching sunglasses.</p> <hr/> <hr/>
<p>were</p> <p>'Were' is the plural past tense form of 'to be'. 'Were' might be used to describe something in the past or to talk about what a group of people were doing in the past.</p>		<p>We were walking in the countryside.</p> <p>The clouds were white and fluffy.</p> <hr/> <hr/>

'We're' is short for 'we are'. 'We're' can be used to talk about the future as well as describing the present.
